After School Club

FPS After School Club is a place for children to unwind after the school day. Children are able to participate in activities similar to those they would do at home, eg: board games, outdoor play, model making, drawing and colouring, baking or they can even relax with a movie.

A light evening snack is served at 3.30pm or 4pm (for children attending additional after school clubs).

Evening snacks consist of a variety of hot/ cold food. All food served is not intended as a substitute for a main evening meal.

Individual dietary requirements are catered for where possible. All staff are to be made aware of children's allergies and food safety guidelines are followed. We have been awarded a Hygiene Rating of 5, the highest rating possible.

Arrival and Departure

Our Wraparound Club is located in the school library, which is inside our locked perimeter fence. On arrival to Breakfast Club a door bell is rung, located by the gate, and the children are collected by a staff member and a register is signed. The club is open from 7:45am, children arriving early wait with their parents in the car park .

After School provision requires children to be signed in by a staff member and signed out by parent/carer when collected. The latest collection time is 6:00pm. Again, the doorbell is rung and children are escorted to the locked gate and a register is signed.

If you are unable to collect your child for any unforeseen reason, a password system is adopted to ensure we know whom your child is being collected by.
